### **Successful Design Build Program for LMI**

"We are pleased to see our completed slat assemblies on this high-technology aircraft," said Lager. "It has been a pleasure working with Embraer and we look forward to the first flight scheduled to take place by the end of this year."

There are 10 moveable slat assemblies per aircraft. This program is a joint effort involving several LMI facilities with the slat assembly occurring in our facility in St. Charles, MO and the skins and machine formed structural components fabricated in other plants in California, Kansas and Missouri.
